The following rules have been established to administer the St. Francis Parish Scholarship Fund:

1. Eligibility: Applicant must be a member of St. Francis Catholic Parish, and a graduating senior who wishes to further his/her education at a college, university, or technical school. Applicant must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. The scholarship will be granted regardless of race, color, or gender.
2. Application: Application for the scholarship must be submitted no later than 3:00pm, **Wednesday, March 20, 2018**

3. Scholarship Amount: The amount of each scholarship to be awarded will be determined by the Scholarship Committee. **No scholarship will exceed one thousand dollars.**
4. Announcement: The scholarship will be awarded at the 8:30am Mass, May 19, 2019, and at the Ellsworth Senior High School Awards Program Sunday, May 19. The scholarship money will be paid to the recipients attending school after the first grading period of the fall term.
